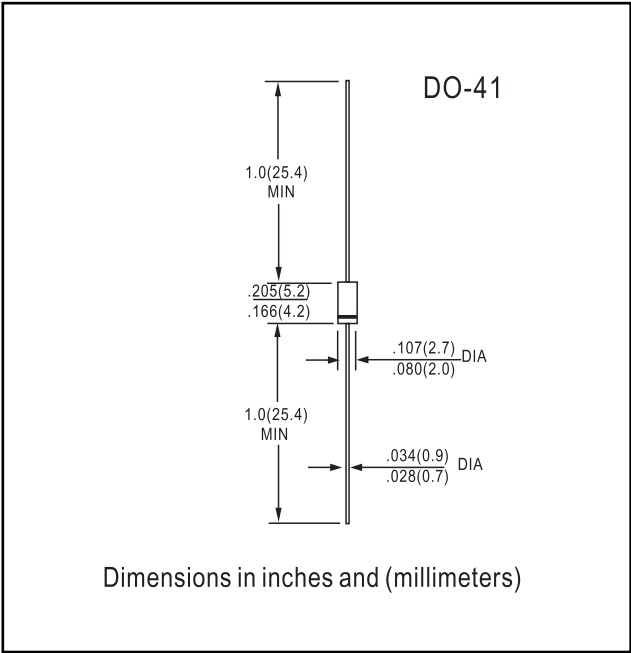

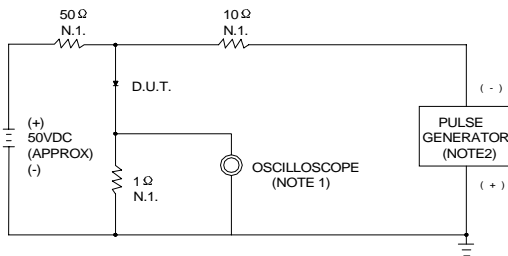

2. RISE TIME=10ns MAX. SOURCE IMPEDANCE=50Ω

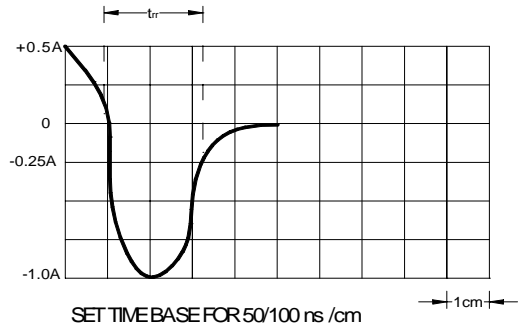


FIG.2 – TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTIC

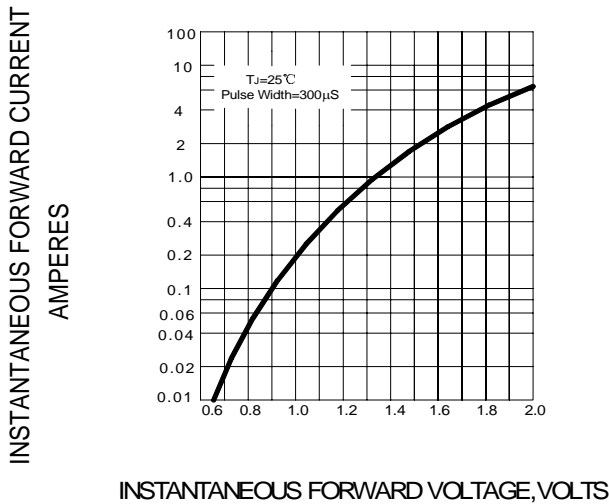


FIG.3 – FORWARD DERATING CURVE

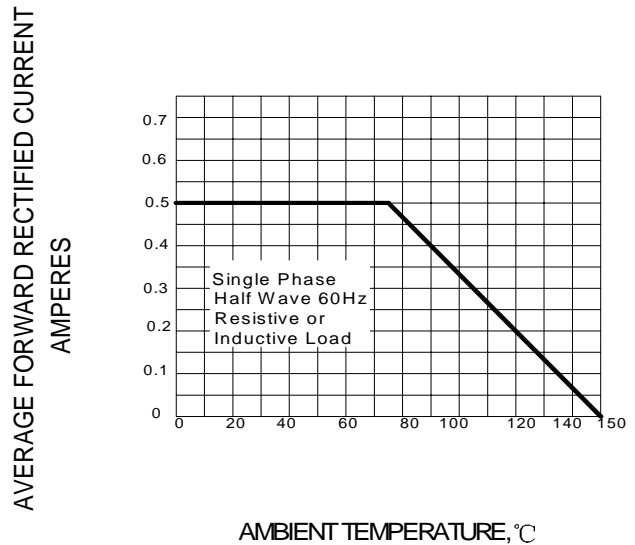


FIG.4 – TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE

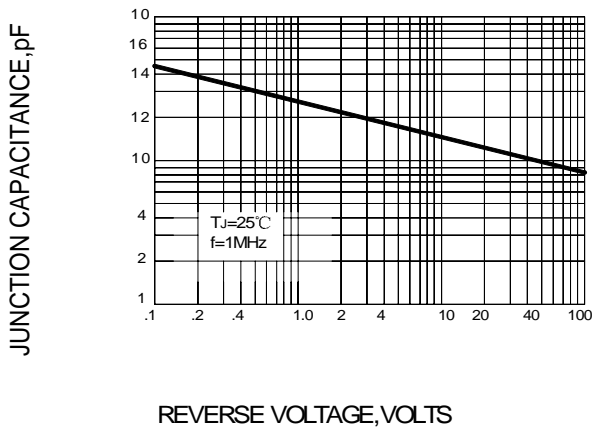


FIG.5 – PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT
