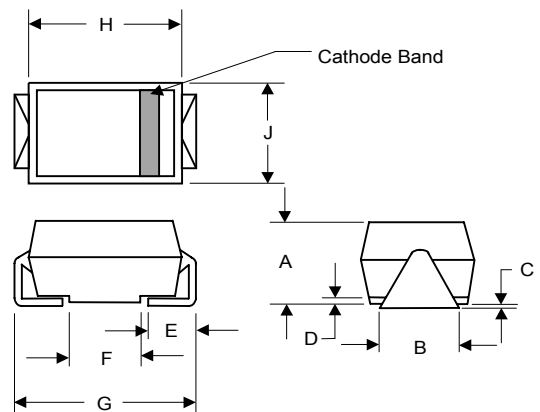

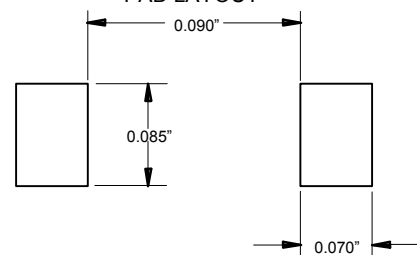

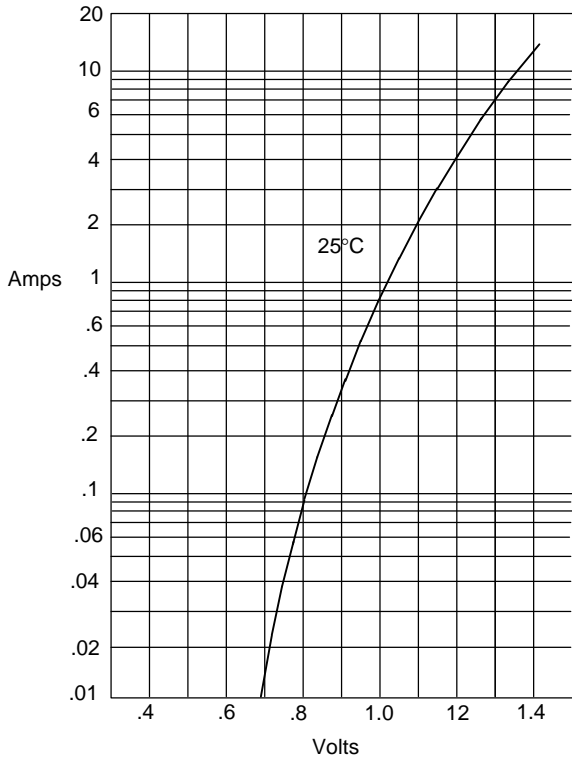

#### SUGGESTED SOLDER PAD LAYOUT



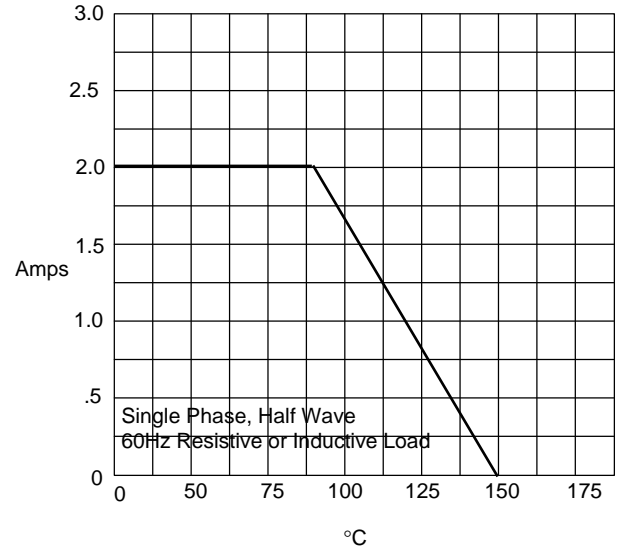

Typical Forward Characteristics



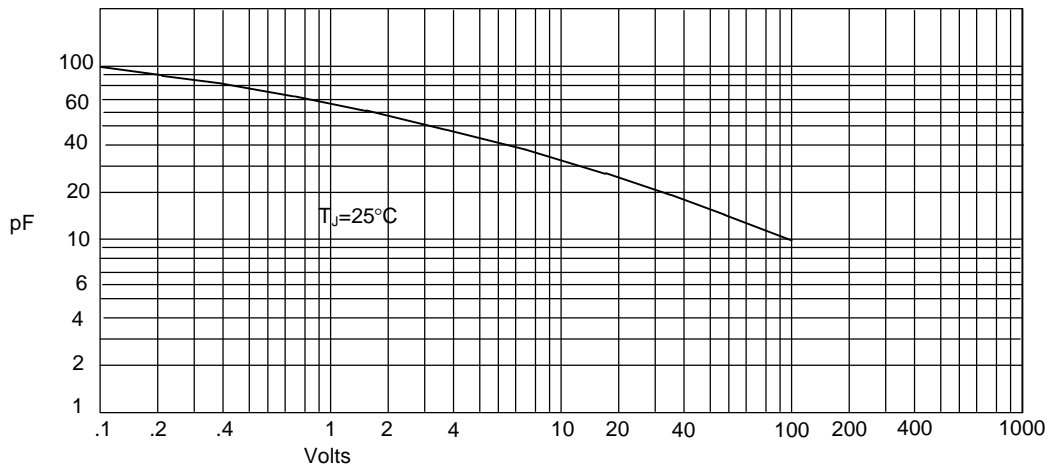
Instantaneous Forward Current - Amperes *versus*

Ambient Temperature - °C

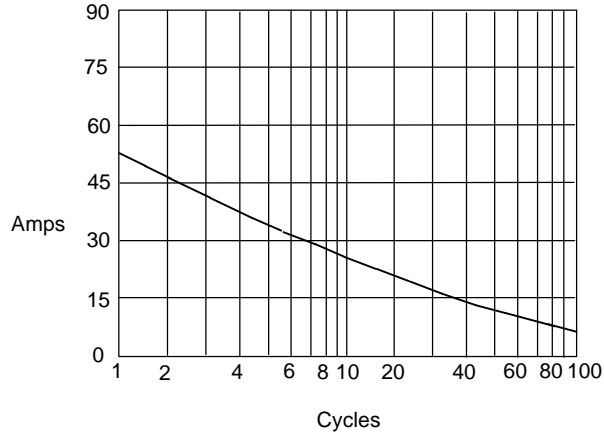

Reverse Voltage - Volts

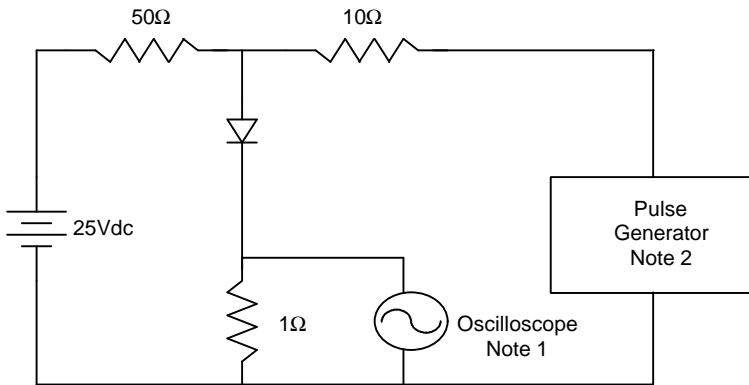
